



Frequently Asked Questions

What age children can participate in the dance classes?

Classes are available for children age 3 (by September 1, 2009) through 5th grade and students in middle school, high school, and college.

What classes are available?

- Preschool (*age 3 through 5*) - Creative Movement classes meet once a week for 1 hour.
- Elementary (*K through 5th grade*) - Ballet classes meet once a week for 1 hour. Beginning in first grade, students have the option of adding a half-hour jazz class after ballet. (*Students must be enrolled in ballet class to take jazz.*)
- Middle/High School, College - Modern Jazz classes meet once a week for 1 ½ hours.

How much is tuition?

Tuition is \$40 per month for 1-hour classes, \$55 per month for 1 ½ -hour classes. Families with multiple children participating in the program receive 10% off their total tuition.

How do I register for classes?

Registration forms are available online at www.burnthickory.com/danceministry. There is a yearly *non-refundable* registration fee of \$20 per family due at the time of registration that reserves the student's spot on the class roster. Registration forms and fees should be returned to the church office.

When do classes begin?

Classes begin September 8, 2009 (the Tuesday after Labor Day).

Do I have to be a member of Burnt Hickory to participate?

No. Classes are available to anyone.

How often do the dancers perform?

Students perform at least twice a year. In December, the dancers give an informal, in-class performance of their Christmas choreography to their parents and close family. The Spring Performance in May is the "end-of-year recital" and is open to the public.
